

Lots Z-AD - For additional information see Arcata Redwood Co. in CO-1 file. Also, Hofsted, Eugene A., World's Tallest Tree Farm - Follow-up for the Future, American Forests, Sept. 1964. At present these trees are in the Redwood National Park (11/3/69). As of Nov. 1969 the following were still alive in the lathhouse

Lot AH- tree and when rooted the ramet turned out not to be normal. Libby thinks the ramet may be missing 7 chromosomes. This clone is apparently male and female sterile. LCJ 2/15/74

Lot AI--These seeds did not go down th the moon but stayed in the Kitty Hawk module. Seeds sent to IFG by SO and were germinated Aug. 1972. Cuttings from the seedlings were requested by SLKrugman and these are Lot AJ. LCJ 9/2/75

Lot AJ-- Rooted cuttings from seedlings of "Moon Trees". Cuttings were taken 1/3 and 2/28/75 and rooted in an attempt to get 100 cuttings to give the states for the bicentennial. LCJ 9/2/75
